Senior class dues this year will be \$250 which will cover *everything*. Everything includes: caps, gowns, tassels, senior trip expenses, and class night party. This money will be due on **10/25**. Checks are payable to EJHS class of 2019. **\*\*\*If you do not go on the senior trip, your class dues will be \$25, not \$250.\*\*\***

Note: If you decide to **not go** on the senior trip, you will have to write a 10 page research paper on Washington DC (see Mr. Benner for details – this is school district policy).

Fundraiser information: The sandwiches will be from Mexico Market. Profit margin: Students get \$1.25 per sandwich until the class dues of \$250 is met. After the student hits their goal of \$250, a \$1.00 profit per sandwich can be made that can be used for spending money on the trip.

\*\*\* Parents who have the proper clearances are encouraged to chaperone the senior walk-through of the elementary schools towards the end of the year.

\*\*\* A point of emphasis: Students will need to wear nice dress clothes for not only at Toby's on the senior trip but also for Baccalaureate, Class Night, and Graduation. Guys – nice dress shirts, ties, and dress shoes (single solid color dress shoes) and ladies should wear nice dresses or very nice pants. Dresses should meet the requirements of the school dress code.

\*\*\* Decorating graduation caps: Please only decorate the top of the cap (the flat part) and make sure the decorations are two dimensional (nothing sticking up) and keep the decorations tasteful and appropriate. Thanks!

Third senior class meeting: **Thursday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> at 8:30 a.m.** in the auditorium for Baccalaureate and Class Night discussion and for students to get their caps, gowns, and tassels and for them to have their senior class photo taken (as a whole class) in their caps and gowns.

Class Night: **Tuesday, 5/28 at 7:00 p.m.** auditorium. Students need to arrive **at 6:30** to get ready. Students will need to wear nice dress clothes (see above requirements) but do NOT need to wear their caps and gowns. There will be a Class Night party immediately following the conclusion of class night at The Bread of Life. Students are free, guests (one guest only -- no parents/guardians) are \$5.00.

Baccalaureate: **Sunday, 6/2 at 7:00 p.m.** auditorium. Students need to arrive **at 6:30** to get ready. Students need to wear nice dress clothes (see above requirements) AND they need to wear their caps, gowns, and tassels.

Graduation Practice: **Wednesday, 6/5 at 9:00 a.m.** auditorium. Students MUST be here for the graduation practice. It should last about an hour.

Graduation: **Wednesday, 6/5 at 7:00 p.m.** auditorium. Students need to arrive **at 6:30** to get ready. Students need to wear nice dress clothes (see above requirements) AND they need their caps, gowns, and tassels.

Re: Suggestions for the class trip

1. The Senior Class trip is an extension of the East Juniata High School and all school rules apply with regard to dress, banned substances, etc. Smoking? Vaping? Rooms are non-smoking and non-vaping. Risk a fine!
2. Arrival time at EJ on Wednesday is 6:30 AM. Boys should bring luggage into the cafeteria and girls should take their luggage to the library. Luggage will be searched. If you want to pack food that is fine and all liquids in sealed containers. There are snack/soda machines in the hotel.
3. One large piece of luggage should suffice (once on the bus on Wed. it stays on the bus!!!!). Small carry on bag is permissible (small collapsible umbrella is advised and a jacket).
4. Front seats on the bus are reserved for the chaperones
5. Please AVOID using the bathroom on the bus.
6. We will stop for a rest break at Thurmont, MD on the way to Washington DC. Students could eat breakfast there. This is one place where the class does NOT pay for your food. Suggested amount for cash to bring along would be \$20 for food and more if you wish to buy souvenirs.
7. Lunch at the zoo on Wednesday (money provided from the class but this is a good time to pack your own lunch). Wednesday night we will eat at Ronald Reagan Building( you will get a food coupon here).
8. Be sensitive at the memorials on Wednesday—vets and loved ones of deceased may be present.
9. Hotel time on Wednesday night—Girls/Boys in rooms, pizza orders, noise, other patrons, curfew. GET SOME SLEEP!! The hotel rooms have coffee pots, microwaves, refrigerators. **You will have doors taped and chaperones/security will sit up all night.**
10. Check your rooms for anything broken. UNPLUG YOUR ROOM PHONE!!!
11. Breakfast on Thursday and Friday is at the hotel. Rise and shine at 6:30-7:00—head to busses at 7:45—leave at 8:00.
12. Lunch at the museum on Thursday (cash from class).
13. Sensitivity to the visitors at the Holocaust Museum and at Arlington Cemetery.
14. School dress is fine for Wednesday—Friday. Wear SENSIBLE shoes. We will DRESS UP on Thursday evening for the show at Toby's. Girls—dressy dresses. Guys—shirt, tie, and no jeans. Special drinks and souvenirs at Toby's—Tip is included in your meal ticket.
15. Friday breakfast is at hotel. We will go to the Supreme Court and the Capitol building. Then Lunch at the Ronald Reagan Building and Arlington—all paid for.
16. We will stop at Thurmont, MD on the way home again.
17. We maintain the schedule—NO ONE stays on the bus.
18. NO loud stereos but Ipods/Iphones are fine. No large metal belt buckles or chains.
19. BRING A CELL PHONE and an umbrella.
